

Disaster risk has become more complex due to the impending effects of climate change, disruptive technology, rapid infrastructure development, and growing anthropogenic pressures. Under current development pathways, we should prepare to face the possibility of more compounding hazards and complex risk landscapes in the future.

The "4th International Symposium on Disaster Resilience and Sustainable Development", referred to as DRSD 2025, organized by the Asian Institute of Technology, gathers experts, practitioners, policymakers, and students from Asia Pacific and beyond to present a discourse on improving development practices to reduce long-term complex risks and promote equitable sustainability. The international symposium will be held from 24-26 November 2025 as a fully in-person event.
